



Zone 10 Requirements and Split Guidelines

Section 1: Region Information

Zone 10 will be split into 4 Regions.

Region 1

11 teams. Region 1 will include San Diego County north to San Luis Obispo County including all counties east and south of Fresno County in the east. The State of Hawaii is included in Region 1 as are any teams in the Las Vegas area in Nevada.

Region 2

11 teams. Region 2 will include Monterey, San Benito, King, Santa Cruz, parts of Santa Clara and San Mateo counties. Santa Clara and San Mateo county teams will be split between Regions 2 and 4 as required for hosting purposes.

Region 3

9 teams. Region 3 will include all counties from Fresno north to the Oregon border, including NV teams in the Reno area, west to Contra Costa and Alameda Counties. Yolo County north to the Oregon border.

Region 4

10 teams. Region 4 will include teams in Santa Clara and San Mateo Counties as needed to assist in hosting.

All teams in counties north of San Mateo will be included in Region four, San Francisco, Marin, Sonoma, Napa north to the Oregon border.

Section 2: Post Season Format

Each Region will host a Region Final, over either one or two days as needed per qualifying rider counts for both team and individual riders.

Section 3: Post Season Dates

Regular Season will run Aug 1, 2021 and conclude February 13, 2022 as the last day for regular season shows.

Region finals may run from February 28 through March 6, 2021. Final Region dates TBD.

Historically, the Zone has asked for a one-time voluntary donation of \$25 per rider to cover overages due to needing to hire covered arenas for finals.
