



Zone 10 Requirements and Split Guidelines

Section 1: Region Information

Zone 10 will be split into 4 Regions.

Region 1

11 teams. Region 1 will include San Diego County north to San Luis Obispo County including all counties east and south of Fresno County in the east. The State of Hawaii is included in Region 1 as are any teams in the Las Vegas area in Nevada.

Region 2

12 teams. Region 2 will include Monterey, San Benito, King, Santa Cruz; Santa Clara and San Mateo county teams will be split between Regions 2 and 4 as required for hosting purposes.

Region 3

10 teams. Region 3 will include all counties from Fresno north to the Oregon border, including NV teams in the Reno area, west to Contra Costa and Alameda Counties in the East Bay. Yolo County north to the Oregon border.

Region 4

7 teams. Region 4 will include teams in the following counties: San Francisco, Marin, Sonoma, Napa north to the Oregon border will be Region 4; Santa Clara and San Mateo county teams will be split between Regions 2 and 4 as required for hosting purposes.

Section 2: Post Season Format

Each Region will host a Region Final, over either one or two days as needed per qualifying rider counts for both team and individual riders.

8301 Regional Finals must be considered a community effort. All teams and individual riders who qualify to compete are expected to participate in the organization and/or running of the Regional Final in some way; including but not limited to providing a facility, schooling riders, show staff, volunteers, and horses.

8401 Zone Finals must be considered a community effort. All teams and individual riders who qualify to compete are expected to participate in the organization or running of the Zone Final in some way; including but not limited to providing a facility, schooling riders, show staff, volunteers, and horses.

Section 3: Post Season Dates

Riders will advance to Region finals with an accrual of 18 points in individual classes.
Teams qualify with 20 points.

Regular Season will run Aug 1, 2022 and conclude February 12, 2023 as the last day for regular season shows.

Region finals may run from February 25 through March 12, 2022. Final Region dates TBD.

Riders will advance from Region to Zone finals on a proportional basis, based on rider counts per region. A total of twelve individual and twelve teams will advance from Region to Zone Finals.

Section 4: Fundraising Information

Each region will be responsible for fundraising & support of their own regional finals. All Regional Finals shows are expected to cover their own costs and break even financially - profits will be rolled into Zone Finals budget. Approved fundraisers at regular or region shows may be basket raffles, VIP table sales, t-shirts, and monetary donations.

Budgets for Region Finals are due from Region Presidents by Sept 1.

Zone 10 has appointed a committee to make recommendations for fundraising efforts.

Historically, Zone 10 has asked for a one-time voluntary donation of \$25 per rider to cover overages due to the need for covered arenas for finals.
