



Zone 7 Requirements and Split Guidelines 2021-2022

Section 1: Region Information

- Region 1 – Kansas, Missouri, Oklahoma & Arkansas**
- Region 2 – Northeast Texas & North Louisiana**
- Region 3 – Central & Southwest Texas**
- Region 4 – North Texas & West Texas**
- Region 5 – South Louisiana/South Texas (Houston Area)**

- Hunt Seat will remain at 5 regions with 7-13 teams originally assigned, approximately 85-156 riders per region.

Section 2: Post Season Format

- There will be no more than 12 riders per individual class and no more than 12 teams at Zone Finals.
- Each region is guaranteed 2 spots in both individual classes and the team competition.
- The remaining 2 spots will be allotted based on rider population in each region as of December 31 each year.

Section 4: Fundraising Information

Each region will be responsible for fundraising & support of their own regional finals. All Regional Finals shows are expected to cover their own costs and break even financially - profits will be rolled into Zone Finals budget. Approved fundraisers at regular or region shows may be basket raffles, VIP table sales, t-shirts, and cash donations

8301 Regional Finals must be considered a community effort. All teams and individual riders who qualify to compete are expected to participate in the organization and/or running of the Regional Final in some way; including but not limited to providing a facility, schooling riders, show staff, volunteers, and horses.

8401 Zone Finals must be considered a community effort. All teams and individual riders who qualify to compete are expected to participate in the organization or running of the Zone Final in some way; including but not limited to providing a facility, schooling riders, show staff, volunteers, and horses.

- Fundraising for Finals may consist of;
 - Silent auction w/ gift basket requests from each team attending (using money as a sponsorship equally divided among all qualified individuals for National Finals)
 - T-Shirt Sales; percentage from vendor (all funds towards Zone Finals expenses)
 - Priority seating at arena tables (\$1000 of funds to Senior Scholarship, remaining towards Zone Finals expenses)
 - Program Ad sales (all funds towards Zone Finals expenses)
 - Prize Sponsor (all funds towards Zone Finals awards)
 - Vendor booths (all funds towards Zone Finals expenses)
 - Horsemanship Test (monies will go into Zone 7 sportsmanship scholarship)
