



## 2020-2021 Zone 8 Requirements and Split Guidelines

### Section 1: Region Information

- Zone 8 shall consist of 4 Regions with 7-10 Teams originally assigned
  - Region 1- North Colorado, Utah
  - Region 2- South Colorado, NM
  - Region 3- West Colorado, Utah
  - Region 4- Arizona, Utah, NM
- New teams may be assigned to a Region outside of their geographic area if the size of the team, horse or facility-availability dictate need or the size of the Region dictates a change

### Section 2: Post Season Format

- There will be twelve (12) riders in each individual class at Zone Finals
- Twelve (12) qualified teams that will be allowed per class at Zone Finals
- Each Region shall be allowed 3 (individual and team) slots at Zone Finals
- Any remaining spots will be allotted based on rider population in each Region as of December 1st each year
- In accordance with IEA Rule 8501.4, IEA reserves the right to make changes to the Regional, Zone or National Finals schedule and/or procedures of competition provided any changes to the standard format are approved by the IEA Executive Committee.

### Section 4: Fundraising Information

- Any Region may fundraise for their Region Finals Horse Show. All fundraising proposals must be submitted by the Region President to the Zone Administrator for approval no later than 60 days prior to the date of the Final. Preapproved fundraisers listed below are exempt from additional approval.
- Region Finals must be considered a community effort. All teams and individuals competing are expected to participate in the organization and/or running of the Region Final in some way: including but not limited to providing horses, providing a facility, schooling riders, show staff, volunteers and class sponsors.
- Each Region will be responsible for fundraising and support of their own regional finals. All Region Finals are expected to cover their own costs and break even financially. Profits will be rolled over into the Zone Finals Budget. Approved Fundraisers at Regular or Region Shows may be raffles, silent auctions, VIP Tables, T-shirts and cash donations.
- Zone Finals must be considered a community effort. All teams and individuals competing are expected to participate in the organization and/or running of the Zone Finals in some way, including but not limited to providing horses, Providing a facility, schooling riders, show staff, volunteers and class sponsors.
- Zone Finals fundraising will include silent auction (proceeds go to the two teams moving on to National Finals divided equally between one middle school team and one high school team), 50/50

Raffles, VIP Tables, clothing items, class sponsorship, ads in the program, sale of box seats and cash donations,

- There are 26 Classes that are to be sponsored at Zone Finals. Each Region is requested to find sponsors for a minimum of 6 classes. The cost of a class sponsorship shall not exceed \$100.

**8301** Regional Finals must be considered a community effort. All teams and individual riders who qualify to compete are expected to participate in the organization and/or running of the Regional Final in some way; including but not limited to providing a facility, schooling riders, show staff, volunteers, and horses.

**8401** Zone Finals must be considered a community effort. All teams and individual riders who qualify to compete are expected to participate in the organization or running of the Zone Final in some way; including but not limited to providing a facility, schooling riders, show staff, volunteers, and horses.
