## **Pertinent Rules:**

**4204.5 A competition day cannot exceed 200 rides without prior approval of the Zone Administrator. The intended size of the show(s) must be included in the show hosting application(s) and must comply with all local and state guidelines. Additional rides must be approved by the Zone Administrator no later than the closing date of the event(s).**

**4202.4 Acceptable use of horses in IEA competitions is to schedule and use each mount no more than 5 - 8 times (including scheduled and alternate rides) in any one day of competition. Each horse's specific ride count should be based upon characteristics of the horse, facility, courses, patterns, tests, and judging.**
