Horse Descriptions

Reining/Ranch Horses

- **Oakley (Nothin But Chrome)** Straight forward, easy draw. This boy loves his job! Enjoy the ride.
- **Toby (Marciak)** Ranch type. Keep outside leg on for lope, great extended trot, good ride. Division appropriate spurs, crop option.
- **King (Ceddia)** Good draw. Keep him on lead, will swap leads if rider doesn't use leg/hand in circles to keep engaged. Soft hand. Rowell spurs
- **Hollywood (Ceddia)** She gets anxious/nervous. Riders need to use soft hands and keep legs around to comfort her. If she leans, dont just drive a leg in and force her, use leg and hand to straighten. Take care of spins that nose is straight. **2 hand option Ball Spurs**
- **Earl (Ceddia)** Can get dancy in the middle, maintain light control with leg and hand. If he gets forward, don't just pull and hold as he will pull harder. Give and take with soft hands. **2 hand option Ball Spurs**
- **Homer (Ceddia)** Set up for left lead. Can get dancy in middle. Take care of start of maneuvers as he can get pushy. Ball or rowell spurs, recommend ball spurs if rider doesn't know how to use rowels to soften face.
- **Reggie (Concord)** Great guy, he gets a little anxious in the center so don't hang out there. The more relaxed you ride the better. Not a big stopper so don't run hard. Ball spur or will go without.
- **JR (Concord)** Ranch/HMS Simple and LAZY! Ride forward in all gates or he will break. Easy lead change. Rowell spurs
- **Whizbang (Schwarz)**-Set up for lead departures. Ride with slack in the reins. Dont run hard in pattern. Rowell spurs
- **Mickey (Schwarz)**-soft quiet hands and legs. Light contact with the bridle. Dont run hard in pattern. **NO SPURS**
- **Chubs (Schwarz)** Ranch/HMS-ride with slack in reins, set up for leads. Rowell spurs

- **Chisum (Need a Hand)** - Super cute and honest ride! Ride leg to hand and keep him organized at the lope or he will break gait. Ride him forward. Establish trot and then post, or he will lope. Division appropriate spurs and one handed only.
- **Diamond (Need a Hand)** - Can be lazy, keep leg on and remind her to go every stride. Division appropriate spur and one handed only.
- **Gunador (Need a Hand)** - Ride leg to hand. Ask for spin with hand first and help with leg. Keep him straight thru the middle for horsemanship. Division appropriate Spurs and one handed only.
- **Mesa (Dare)** AQHA buckskin mare. Really cute. Has easy gaits. Set up for leads. Ranch horse. Very quiet. DO NOT KICK HER IN THE BUTT WHEN YOU MOUNT OR DISMOUNT!! May wear ball or rowel spurs. ANY DIVISION and RAIL
- **Logan (Cooper) Ranch/HMS**- rein contact with leg pressure to keep frame. Ball or rowell spurs
- **Luvy (Cooper) Ranch/HMS**- rein contact with leg pressure to keep frame. Legs off to stop and standing. Ball or rowell spurs
- **Harriett (Cooper)**- Keep leg on in circles, especially through the middle, will need spurs for spins. Leg release for stops. Ball or rowell spurs, 2 hand option
- **Lena (Cooper)** ONLY 3 runs in reining, can do ranch/hms as well-Loose to light rein contact, use leg pressure to steer, release legs to stop, spurs optional ball or rowell spurs
- **Dexter (Cooper) Ranch/HMS**-better hms
- **Chic (Blackburn) Ranch/HMS**-reining trained horse that works mainly off of leg pressure. Say whoa to stop. Rowel spurs.
- **Bob (Mathias) Ranch/HMS** 2 Handed Great pattern horse, sit square or she will lean. Take your time or she will get flustered. DONT TIGHTEN GIRTH!! NO CROP AND NO SPUR

Horsemanship Horses

- **Prada (DMB)** - Rides like a ranch horse, soft rein contact, constant tap pressure with legs to keep in gait. Ride her forward and if you lose your seat she will stop. Can get frustrated when she feels trapped. If asked to line up, pull to the end of the line. Ball Spur only and two hand option.
- **Wyatt (DMB)** - Easy, straight forward draw, will go off a drape and all leg (preferred) but will also listen to a direct contact rein. Division appropriate spurs option and one handed only.
- **Klu (DMB)** - Klu will try to rush you through her whole ride, but can easily be packaged up. Ride every step slower with seat, hand, legs. Voice cues will easily keep her motivated. NO SPUR and two hand option.

- **Harvey (DBF)** - Easy, straight forward draw, retired show horse. Division appropriate spurs and **1 or 2 HANDED?**
- **Jet (DBF)** - Easy, straight forward draw with a big stride. He will slow down and collect up nicely. Division appropriate spurs and **1 or 2 HANDED?**
- **Amos (DBF)** - Can get lazy, ride every step. Keep him straight and upright with your leg. Ball Spur only and **1 or 2 HANDED?**
- **Cowboy (Concord)** Takes a lot of leg to keep rounded up in the lope. Can lope like a fancy pleasure horse if you make him. Does have a flying lead change so keep inside leg quiet. Rowell spur. **Upper divisions**
- **GiGi (Concord)** The sweetest mare ever! She likes it if you talk to her if she is feeling a little quick. **NO SPURS, Walk/Jog classes**
- **Wesley (Concord)** **2 Handed** A little on the greener side, set up for your right lead by keeping his nose and body to the inside. Keep him slow or he will be very bouncy! **NO SPURS Upper divisions**
- **Hannah (Concord)** straight forward and nothing fancy. Soft hand or she will get flustered and go faster. **NO SPURS**
- **Mercedes (Concord)** The queen of team riding! Just let her go around, she does not bridle up. Set up for right lead. Ball or rowell spurs. Can use a crop. All divisions
- **Spot (Dare)** AQHA bay gelding. ride with light contact. Set up for leads and keep him collected. Can get nervous if asked to stop and stand on the rail. Will do patterns but you will need to keep his attention. May use ball or rowel spurs. Rowel spurs recommended later in the day. Use good judgement. Any division
- **Cupcake (Dare)** APHA mare, **W/J ONLY** Should ride with 2 hands She is good natured and good around other horses. May use ball spurs. Nice soft jog.
- **Romeo (Dare)** AQHA Red dun gelding. Must ride with contact. Set up for leads. Dont use spurs excessively. Ball or rowel spurs. Can do nicely in horsemanship patterns. Any division.
- **Dillion (Dare)** AQHA Red dun gelding. **W/J ONLY** Ride with 2 hands for the best ride but can ride 1 handed. Must wear ball spurs to get him to trot. Retired reining horse.
- **Vera (Dare)** AQHA bay mare. Walks and jogs nicely. Must set up for leads and keep collected at the lope. Lope will be a little faster like a ranch horse. May ride with ball or rowell spurs. Rowell spurs recommended to lope. Retired reining horse. **REINING, RANCH or RAIL ONLY, NO HMS PATTERNS**
- **Dash (Mathias)** **Height Limit** He's a retired reiner. Great guy. Pretty simple to ride and chill. Can frame up and be soft. Can wear a small ball spur. All divisions

- Jinx (Mathias) **Weight Limit** Great rail horse! Kind and bomb proof. Needs a bit of set up for right lead. Slow and steady. All divisions
- Miley (Mathias) **2 Handed** Forward mover. Really need to use your leg and seat. Kind and stout. Simple to ride. All divisions.
- Lola (Wilmington) Easy Ride, set up hard for right lead. All divisions
- Smokey (Wilmington) Easy and honest horse, may need a crop. All divisions
- Minnie (Wilmington) Easy to ride. A bit green so will look around a bit. **Intermediate or Walk/Jog only**
- Cowboy W (Wilmington) More go than whoa. Rancher type. All divisions
