HORSE HOLDING SCHEDULE

In order to run a smooth show, we will need every team to help with HORSE HOLDING duties throughout the day. This is a BIG EVENT with nearly 50 horses to wrangle throughout the day. To fairly do this, we have assigned times for teams to help based on the number of riders attending so that no one is stuck in the paddock all day. Paddock Horse Holders can be riders and/or adults or parents with horse experience. If there happens to be enough horse holders during your team's assigned time-slot, please return at a later time or when asked. We want to avoid having to repeatedly announce for horse holders in the paddock this year. It slows down the show and projects a negative image for attendees and on the live stream. **Thank you for your cooperation.**

NOTE: These assignments are in addition to any team's own responsibilities with the horses they brought.

When horses need to be brought to or from the barn area - THERE MUST BE AN ADULT, COACH, HORSE PROVIDER, or experienced UPPER SCHOOL RIDER in addition to any younger riders/horse handlers. **No elementary or middle school rider should be walking alone to the barn or arena with a horse.** *(It is a long way from arena to the barn across a busy lot.)*
