



## 2023-2024 Zone 3 Requirements and Split Guidelines

### Region Information (Hunt Seat):

- Hunt Seat will be split into 11 regions with 6-11 teams originally assigned to each Region.
- Regular Season Start Date: August 1, 2023
- The final weekend for regular season shows will be January 21, 2024
- All regular season shows must be approved by the Regional President and Zone Administrator.

### Postseason Format

- There will be no more than 14 riders per individual class and no more than 14 teams at Zone Finals.
- Each region is guaranteed 1 spot in both individual and team competition.
- The remaining spots will be allotted based on rider population in each region as of December 1<sup>st</sup> each year.
- When determining Zone Final allotments, if there is a tie for additional rides, the ride will first go to the host region if they are one of the tied teams, if they are not, the tie will then be broken through a random draw.

### Post Season Dates

- Region Finals are to be scheduled by Regional Presidents by 9/15/2023. They must be at least 10 business days prior to Zone 3 Finals and at least 10 business days after the last regular season show.
- Zone 3 Finals, March 2024, Location TBD.
- IEA Nationals, April 2024, Location TBD

### Fundraising Information

**G8301** Region Finals must be considered a community effort. All teams and individual riders who qualify to compete are expected to participate in the organization and/or running of the Regional Final in some way: including but not limited to providing a facility, schooling riders, show staff, volunteers and horses.

**G8401** Zone Finals must be considered a community effort. All teams and individual riders who qualify are expected to participate in the organization or running of the Zone Finals in some way, including but not limited to providing a facility, schooling riders, show staff, volunteers, and horses.

- Each region will be responsible for fundraising & support of their own Region Finals. All Region Finals shows are expected to cover their own costs and break even financially - profits will be rolled into the Zone Finals budget. Approved fundraisers at regular or region shows may be basket raffles, program ads, VIP table sales, t-shirts, and cash donations. Region Finals must be considered a community effort. All teams and individual riders who qualify to compete are expected to participate in the organization and/or running of the Region Final in some way; including but not limited to providing a facility, schooling riders, show staff, volunteers, and horses.
- Any fundraising plans will be approved by the Zone Administrator prior to implementation.
- Zone Finals will sell ads for the show program, silent auction gift basket donations, and solicit sponsors as a fundraiser for the show. We will also seek prizes and/or cash donations to offset the cost of the show.
