Adult Pilot Hosting Information 2023-2024

Before the show you must:

- Indicate that you are offering adult classes on the *Show Hosting App* OR inform the membership office that your adding them prior to the closing date.
- List the adult classes, info sheet and entry form in your prize list.
- Confirm all Adult Rider entrants are listed on an IEA roster under Contributing Members.

Adult Classes:

WILL NOT show up the Database, you will need to add them into your program manually.

MAY NOT be combined with youth rider classes at any time.

MAY run with a min of 1 rider, and or riders from 1 team.

MAY NOT be split into sections unless there are 12+ riders.

Class 1 (AH1, AW1, AD1) is a class that will have two different levels of riders in them. This class must be judged on the same card unless 12 or more people are entered, in which case the levels can be split into two sections and judged separately.

For example: Adults showing over fences 2' & cross rails should be judged on the same card. They cannot be split into two sections for fences and/or flat unless there are 12 or more.

Class 1 may be run in the show schedule alongside the youth classes, or at the end of the day as suggested in the *Adult Addendum*.

After the show you must:

- Send electronic copies of adult class results and judges cards directly to emily@rideiea.org within 7 business days.
- Check your online points for accuracy before they become final 21 days after posting.
