

# Dressage Split Guidelines and National Allotments 2023-2024

(Updated 12/6/23)



## INTERSCHOLASTIC EQUESTRIAN ASSOCIATION

### **Section 1: Zone Information**

- Dressage is divided into 6 Zones.
- Zones are made up of 1 - 6 regions initially assigned.
- Regions are made up of 3 - 8 teams.
- Regions that show significant growth by October 1, 2023 will be split.
- Regions that have less than 3 active teams or less than 5% of the total Dressage population as of November 1, 2023 will be combined with the nearest Region.
- All shows must hold priority entry to their own region.

### **Section 2: Postseason Format**

- The regular season will begin on August 1, 2023.
- The regular season will end no later than (10) business days from each region's Dressage Regional Finals.
- Dressage Regional Finals will be held no later than (10) business days from each Dressage Zone Finals.
- For regions that advance directly to Dressage Zone Finals, the regular season will end no later than (10) business days from their respective Dressage Zone Finals.
- Individuals must earn 15 individual points during the regular season to qualify for Post Season.
- Teams must earn 20 points during the regular season to qualify for Post Season.
- **Allotments from Regionals to Zone Finals:**
  - Zones with 1-2 regions: All qualified riders and teams advance directly to Zone Finals
  - Zones with 3 regions: 4 individuals/4 teams
  - Zones with 4 regions: 3 individuals/3 teams
- All Dressage post-season shows should be considered a community effort by all participating teams.
- Each active Dressage Zone will have 2 individual and 2 team allotments to Dressage National Finals.
- All Dressage Zone Finals must be completed at least twenty (20) days prior to Dressage National Finals.

- Zone D2: February 16-18, 2024 @ Delaware Valley University
- Zone D3: March 2 – 3, 2024 @ Averett University
- Zone D4: March 1 – 3, 2024 @ Lake Erie College
- Zone D5: February 18 – 19, 2024 @ Oklahoma City Fairgrounds
- Zone D6: March 1 – 3, 2024 @ Devonwood Equestrian Center
- Dressage National Finals – April 25 – 28, 2024 @ Tryon International Equestrian Center - Mill Spring, NC

### **Section 4: Fundraising Information**

- Each Region will be responsible for fundraising and support of their Regional and Zone. Region chairs will work together with the Zone Administrator to plan and execute Finals as a group effort.
- All Regional and Zone Finals are expected to cover their own costs and break even financially.
- Any required fund raising for post-season will be listed in the Prize List.
- Any fund raising required must be submitted with the entry by the closing date.
- Teams are also encouraged to participate in the end of season T-shirt fundraiser.
